GRASSROOTS GRANTS FUND



Managed by the Community Development Foundation Funded by the Office of the Third Sector The Grassroots Grants Fund supports local, voluntary and community groups. It will be available until March 2011.

KEY THEMES

Grant money can be used to fund a wide range of activities, including equipment and core running costs.

CRITERIA

Groups must:

- Have an average income of less than £30,000 or
- Have been established at least 12 months before applying, or have satisfactorily managed a Community Foundation grant previously
- Demonstrate a local need for their project

HOW MUCH?

Maximum of £5,000 over two years. A £900 micro grant is available.

The Borough of Rochdale Fund aims to support locally run projects that contribute positively to the quality of life and wellbeing of people and communities in the borough.

KEY THEMES

The Fund priorities are:

- Safety including crime and disorder
- Sustainable neighbourhoods including environment and housing
- Prosperity, skills and jobs
- Lifelong learning including early years and schools
- Transport
- Health and well-being
- Culture, sports and arts
- Community cohesion including issues of race and disability

CRITERIA

Community-based, volunteer led groups with a constitution and an income of less than $\pounds 150,000.$

HOW MUCH?

Maximum £5,000.
