All nominations will be assessed by a judging panel of individuals with extensive knowledge of issues around equality, an in-depth understanding of the diversity of communities in our Borough and years of practical experiences in either working with or for the communities.

The judges will be looking for that 'extra' quality that an individual or an organisation has which makes them a WORTHY recipient of a Rochdale Diversity Award 2014.

Rules of entry:

- 1. You may nominate yourself (or your own group or organisation) as well as an individual, group or organisation for any of the awards.
- 2. Nominees **must** operate within the Borough of Rochdale.
- 3. If you were a winner of one of the Rochdale Diversity Awards in 2013, then you will clearly have to demonstrate the additional progress that you have made in the last 12 months (if applying for the same category).
